



MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2013-20

REORGANIZATION OF CAAP-AANSOO

WHEREAS, the **CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY OF PHILIPPINES - AERODROME AND AIR NAVIGATION SAFETY OVERSIGHT OFFICE (CAAP - AANSOO)** is mandated to conduct safety audit, surveillance, inspection of thirty six (36) aerodromes due for certification, fifteen (15) due for registration, and more than two hundred fifty (250) airstrips and helipads due for issuance of permit to operate;

WHEREAS, CAAP - AANSOO's mandate also includes the audit surveillance and inspection function of Communication, Navigation and Surveillance-Air Traffic Management (CNS-ATM) facilities consisting of thirty three (33) Aerodrome Control Towers, thirteen (13) Approach Control Facilities, two (2) Area Control Centers, forty (40) Airways Communication Facilities, Meteorological office/s, Aeronautical Information Service, Search and Rescue, fifty three (53) Communication Facilities, ninety five (95) Navigational Aids Facilities, seven (7) Surveillance Facilities, and one hundred twenty two (122) Airfield Power Lighting Facilities;

WHEREAS, the 2009 International Civil Aviation Organization-Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (ICAO-USOAP) manifested CAAP's deficiencies in ensuring sufficient and qualified human resources to meet its national and international obligations related to civil aviation safety oversight;

WHEREAS, the ICAO's unfavorable audit report became the basis of US aviation regulator Federal Aviation Authority (FAA) and the European Union (EU) in downgrading CAAP to Category 2 status barring Philippine air carriers from launching new US and European routes and expanding existing ones;

WHEREAS, the DBM-approved Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern (OSSP) for CAAP-AANSOO, consisting of three (3) divisions with twenty (20) technical positions and two (2) administrative personnel, does not sufficiently meet its national and international safety oversight obligations;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to reorganize CAAP-AANSOO to fully complement it with the sufficient number of qualified safety inspectors and regulation officers;

WHEREAS, the CAAP-AANSOO has requested for approval of its Reorganization, to consist of four (4) divisions with fifty two (52) technical positions and two (2) administrative personnel, as an exemption from the pertinent provisions of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 77, s. of 2012;

WHEREAS, Section 5(a) of R.A. No. 10149 mandates the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) to "evaluate and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department or agency to

which a GOCC is attached...[and] implement [the restructuring] *unless otherwise directed by the President.*”;

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the State and the public to approve the Reorganization of CAAP-AANSOO in the latter’s pursuit of its vital programs and objectives;

NOW, Be it –

RESOLVED, that in view of the exigency of the service, the Reorganization of CAAP-AANSOO, as summarized in **Annex A** hereof, is hereby **APPROVED**;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the CAAP-AANSOO shall consist of four (4) divisions with an authorized staffing pattern of fifty-two (52) technical positions and two (2) administrative positions;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the positions in the authorized staffing pattern of CAAP-AANSOO shall follow the GCG-approved Statement of Functions, as indicated in **Annex B** hereof;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the approval of the Reorganization of CAAP-AANSOO is **SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING**:

1. Supplemental funds for the purpose shall be taken fully from the corporate funds of CAAP, as approved by its Board of Directors, and no budgetary support will be provided by the national government for personal services; and
2. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with.
