



**MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2012-04**

**AUTHORIZING THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA) TO FILL THIRTY-EIGHT (38) REGULAR PLANTILLA POSITIONS NATIONWIDE.**

**WHEREAS**, PPA has requested for authority to fill-up thirty-eight (38) regular plantilla positions as an exemption from the pertinent provisions of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 366, s.2004;

**WHEREAS**, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) pursuant to Republic Act No. 10149 (R.A. No. 10149) mandates the GCG to "evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached";

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the State to allow PPA, as the primary authority to identify its needs as a GOCC to fill-up thirty-eight (38) regular plantilla positions as enumerated hereunder;

**WHEREAS**, a Memorandum has been submitted by the Commission to the President informing His Excellency of the said determination and the Commission has not received any directive otherwise;



**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the authorization to fill-up the foregoing positions is **SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING**:


1. In case the positions are excluded in the staffing pattern under the PPA Rationalization Plan, appointees to said position shall exercise the option available under E.O. No. 366;
2. Funds for the purpose shall be taken from corporate funds of the PPA, which shall be included in its annual Corporate Operating Budget as approved by its Board of Directors; and
3. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with.
