



MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2013-35

AUTHORIZING THE MANILA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY (MIAA) TO CREATE AND FILL ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN (118) POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, the MIAA has requested for authority to create 118 additional positions under the Airport Police Department (APD), as an exemption from the pertinent provisions of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 366, s.2004;

WHEREAS, the creation of the additional positions under the APD may be offset through the abolition of 103 unfilled positions from the same department, in accordance with the Department of Budget and Management's *scrap-and-build* policy;

WHEREAS, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) pursuant to Republic Act No. 10149 (R.A. No. 10149) mandates the GCG to "evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached";

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the State and the public to allow the MIAA, in the latter's pursuit of its vital programs, to create and fill the requested positions as enumerated hereunder;

NOW, Be it –

RESOLVED, the following unfilled positions (See **Appendix 1** for a Detailed Listing of Unfilled APD Items) is hereby **ABOLISHED**:

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the foregoing authorization is **SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING**:

1. In case such positions are excluded in the staffing pattern under the approved MIAA Rationalization Plan, appointees to said positions shall exercise options available under E.O. No. 366 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

2. Funds for the purpose shall be taken fully from the corporate funds of the MIAA, included in its Corporate Operating Budget as approved by its Board of Trustees, and no budgetary support will be provided by the national government for personal services; and
3. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with.
