



## **MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2018-02**

### **AUTHORIZATION TO CREATE AND FILL FOUR (4) EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT POSITIONS OF THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE INSURANCE SYSTEM (GSIS)**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act (R.A) No. 10149 mandates the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) to “evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached”;

**WHEREAS**, Section No. 44 of R.A. No. 8291 provides that "The GSIS President and General Manager shall be assisted by one or more Executive Vice-Presidents (EVP), Senior Vice-Presidents (SVP) and Managers in addition to the usual supervisory and rank-and-file positions who shall be appointed and removed by the President and General Manager (PGM) with the approval of the Board, in accordance with the existing Civil Service rules and regulations”;

**WHEREAS**, the EVP Offices were abolished during the GSIS Reorganization, approved under GCG Memorandum Order No. 2012-08 dated 29 August 2012, to broaden the span of control of the PGM;

**WHEREAS**, the present GSIS Board of Trustees approved the restoration of the EVP Offices together with the necessary personnel, given the breadth and complexity of the operations of GSIS, under Resolution No. 233 dated 28 November 2017;

**WHEREAS**, the GSIS seeks the approval of its proposed restoration of EVP Offices to the GCG on 18 January 2018, to allow the PGM to dedicate more time in analyzing, planning and strategic thinking to ensure that GSIS’ vision is achieved;

**WHEREAS**, the GCG has determined that it is in the best interest of the State to **APPROVE** the creation and filling up of four (4) Executive Vice President positions;

**NOW, BE IT –**

**RESOLVED**, that the GSIS is authorized to create and fill four (4) Executive Vice President (SG 29) positions;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, the the foregoing positions is subject to compliance with the pertinent civil service policies, budgetary, accounting, auditing, and other applicable rules and regulations.
