



MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2024-17

CHANGE IN REPORTING LINE OF PROVINCIAL CASH CENTERS OF THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP)

WHEREAS, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG), pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10149, is mandated to "evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, ...[and] implement the reorganization, merger or streamlining unless otherwise directed by the President";

WHEREAS, the DBP requested for authority to implement changes in the reporting line of Provincial Cash Centers of the Bank in view of its continuing efforts towards efficiency and responsiveness and providing a dynamic organization to address operational and customer requirements;

WHEREAS, the GCG has determined that it is in the best interest of the State and the public to change the reporting line of the Provincial Cash Centers of DBP to promote better, effective and efficient services to the public, in accordance with existing government policy;

NOW, BE IT -

RESOLVED, that the Governance Commission <u>APPROVES</u> the change in the reporting line of the Provincial Cash Centers of DBP through "lock, stock, and barrel," as follows:

Organizational Unit	Existing Reporting Line	New Reporting Line
Provincial Cash Centers (Except Metro Manila Cash Center)	Cash Operations Department	Host Branches

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the implementation in this Order shall comply with the following conditions and guidelines:

- 1. Implementation of the change in the reporting line shall have no added Personal Service Cost to DBP;
- 2. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with; and
- 3. Any further modification/s on the DBP's Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern is/are prohibited unless otherwise approved by the GCG.
