



**MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2016-09**

**AUTHORIZING THE CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (CAAP) TO CREATE ONE HUNDRED NINETY (190) AIR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT OFFICER-I (ATMO-I) POSITIONS UNDER THE AIR TRAFFIC SERVICE (ATS)**

**WHEREAS**, CAAP requested for authority to create three hundred (300) contractual positions in view of the urgent need to retain the services of air traffic controllers recruited as Air Traffic Control (ATC) Assistants under individual temporary job order (JO) service contracts, and in order to maintain its air traffic control operations of Philippine airports;

**WHEREAS**, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10149 mandates the GCG to “evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached”;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the State and the public to grant CAAP the authority to create one hundred ninety (190) ATMO-I positions as specified hereunder;

**NOW**, Be it –

**RESOLVED**, that the request of CAAP is **APPROVED**, and it is hereby authorized to create the ATMO-I positions as follows:


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the authorization to create the foregoing positions is **SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING**:
