





MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2024-09

CHANGE IN REPORTING LINE OF THE POST SHOP, PHILATELY AND MUSEUM DIVISION OF THE PHILIPPINE POSTAL CORPORATION (PHLPost)

WHEREAS, the GCG, through Memorandum Order No. 2012-21 dated 29 October 2012, approved the Rationalization Plan of the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost);

WHEREAS, the PHLPost requested for authority from the GCG to implement operational flexibilities for the Change in Reporting Line of Post Shop, Philately and Museum Division (PPMD) in order to monitor and streamline the process of stamp production to boost the revenue generation the company;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(a) of the "GOCC Governance Act of 2011" (R.A. No. 10149), the GCG is mandated to evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized;

WHEREAS, the GCG has determined that it is in the best interest of the State to implement such change in reporting line;

NOW, BE IT -

RESOLVED, that the request for the change in reporting line of PPMD from the Business Lines Department, Office of the Assistant Postmaster General for Operations to Office of the Postmaster General (OPMG) is hereby APPROVED, *provided,* that such shall apply only during the tenure of PHLPost Acting Postmaster General Luis D. Carlos.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the implementation of this Order shall comply with the following conditions and guidelines:

- a. Implementation of the change in reporting line shall have no additional Personal Service Cost to PHLPost;
- b. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be compiled with; and
- c. Any further medication/s on the PHLPost's Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern is/are prohibited unless otherwise approved by the GCG.
