

## MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2013-09

## AUTHORIZING THE MANILA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY (MIAA) TO FILL THREE (3) CONTRACTUAL POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, the MIAA has requested for authority to fill three (3) contractual positions as an exemption from the pertinent provisions of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 366, s.2004, and DBM Circular Letter No. 2012-20;

WHEREAS, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) pursuant to Republic Act No. 10149 (R.A. No. 10149) mandates the GCG to "evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached";

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the State and the public to allow the MIAA, in the latter's pursuit of its vital programs, to fill three (3) positions as enumerated hereunder;

**RESOLVED FURTHER,** that the authorization to hire the foregoing is **SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING**:

- In case such positions are excluded in the staffing pattern under the approved MIAA RP, appointees to said positions shall exercise options available under E.O. No 366 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;
- Funds for the purpose shall be taken fully from the corporate funds
  of the MIAA, included in its Corporate Operating Budget as
  approved by its Board of Trustees, and no budgetary support will
  be provided by the national government for personal services; and
- 3. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with.
