RETITLING / CONVERSION OF THIRTEEN (13) POSITIONS IN THE NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATION (NEA) TO CHIEF ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the National Electrification Administration (NEA) requested the retitling of thirteen (13) *Chief EC Development/Organizational/Management/Systems Services* (SG-22) positions under the Office of the Deputy Administrator for Field Operations (Management Assistance Group) into *Chief Electric Cooperative Management Services* (SG-22);

WHEREAS, the GCG, pursuant to Section 5(a) of the "GOCC GOVERNANCE ACT OF 2011" (R.A.
