



MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 2019-01

CONVERSION OF MEDICAL OFFICER IV POSITION OF THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA)

WHEREAS, the PPA requested for the upgrading of its existing vacant Medical Officer IV (SG 20) position to Medical Officer V (SG 22) to be able to acquire/hire a permanent doctor who will provide quality medical care to PPA personnel;

WHEREAS, in the organizational structure and staffing pattern of the approved Rationalization Plan (RP) of PPA, as embodied in GCG Memorandum Order (M.O.) No. 2014-10, the position of Medical Officer IV already bears an SG of 22;

WHEREAS, in the Occupational Service of Medicine and Health of the updated Index of Occupational Services (IOS) under Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Budget Circular No. 2018-4, the Medical Officer IV position is provided with an SG of 23;

WHEREAS, under DBM Budget Circular No. 2018-3, the policy is that conversion shall be effected to vacant regular positions in meritorious cases, as may be determined;

WHEREAS, the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10149 mandates the GCG to “evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized, ...[and] implement the reorganization, merger or streamlining *unless otherwise directed by the President*;

WHEREAS, the GCG has determined that it is in the best interest of the State to convert PPA’s existing vacant Medical Officer IV (SG 22) position to Medical Officer IV (SG 23), in accordance with existing government policy;

NOW, BE IT –

RESOLVED, that the Medical Officer IV position of PPA under GCG M.O. No. 2014-10 is hereby **CONVERTED** as follows:

No.	Current Position	SG	Converted Position	SG
1	Medical Officer IV	22	Medical Officer IV	23

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the implementation of this Order shall comply with the following conditions and guidelines:

1. Funds for the purpose shall be taken fully from the corporate funds of the PPA, included in its approved Corporate Operating Budget (COB) as approved by its Governing Board; and

2. The pertinent civil service, budgetary, accounting, auditing and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be complied with.
